Yellow Clinical Waste Sacks

Waste Type: Hazardous / infectious and other waste requiring incineration including anatomical waste – Category A, diagnostic specimens, reagents or test vials and kits containing chemicals.

Method of disposal: Incineration only.

Orange Clinical Waste Sacks

Waste Type: Infectious waste / potentially infectious waste and autoclaved laboratory waste – e.g. soiled dressings, bandages, plastic single use instruments.

Method of disposal: Licensed facility such as Alternative Treatment Plants. It can also be disposed of by incineration.





Offensive / Hygiene Waste Sacks Yellow Sack with Black Stripe

(available in single or multi stripe on both sides)

Waste Type: Human hygiene waste such as incontinence pads, nappies, bedding, plaster casts, etc.

Method of disposal: deep landfill site or Alternative Treatment Plants.

- Yellow and Orange ADR Approved clinical waste sack (suitable for bulk transport) – these sacks are certified to carry up to 25kgs
- > Purple Cytotoxic Clinical Waste Sack
- > Black & Clear NHS Property Household Waste Sacks suitable for packaging, general waste, flowers, etc. These bags can be disposed of in landfill or Alternative Treatment Plants and any recyclable components / waste can be removed before final disposal.
